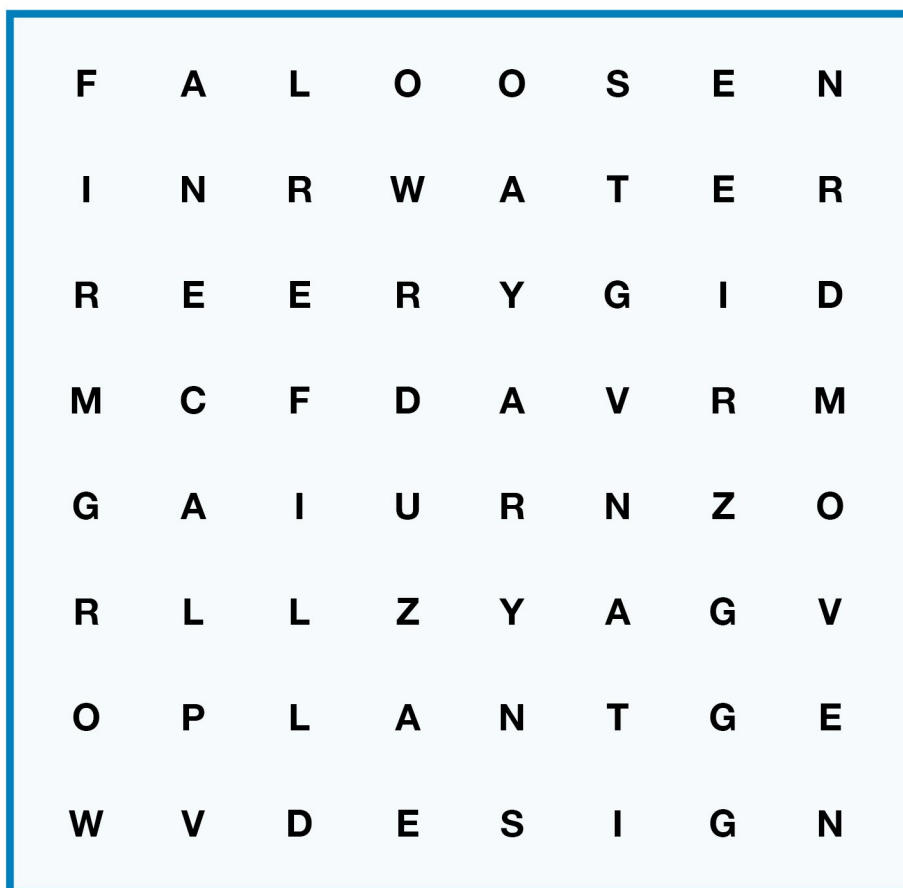




Garden verbs word search

<i>arrange</i>	to put a group of plants in a nice order
<i>design</i>	to plan the look of a garden or part of a garden
<i>dig</i>	to break up or move soil with a tool like a trowel
<i>firm</i>	to fix a plant in the ground by pressing the soil around it
<i>garden</i>	to look after and work in a garden
<i>grow</i>	to help a plant get bigger and more mature
<i>loosen</i>	to make the roots of a potted plant less tight
<i>move</i>	to change the place or position of a plant
<i>place</i>	to put a plant in position
<i>plant</i>	to put a seed, bulb or plant in the ground so that it can grow
<i>refill</i>	to put the soil back in the planting hole
<i>water</i>	to give a plant a drink
