



What do I need?

A5 card

Washable coloured markers

Variety of leaves



What do I do?

Fold your card in half to make a greetings card.

Use your markers to colour sections of a leaf in all the colours of the rainbow - red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and purple.

Place the leaf colour-side down on the front of your greetings card. Press firmly to transfer the colour to the card. Now you have a rainbow leaf print - see how the colours show up the leaf veins.

You can colour and print other rainbow leaves onto your greetings card if you want to.

Why don't you use your greetings card to write to a local NHS worker or another key worker to say thank you? Or you could write it to someone in your family who you haven't seen for a while. You could write a few words on the front of the card too such as 'Thank you', 'I miss you', or 'I love you'.

Tip: You can divide A4 card into two A5 pieces if you need to or make a different sized card.
