



Colours Acrostic Poetry



An acrostic is a particular way of writing a poem. They are written using the first letter of each line which then creates a word or phrase going down the page. Each line can then contain a word, phrase or sentence to make up a poem. They can rhyme but they certainly don't have to. Take a look at some examples below and then see if you can create your own using our Acrostic Poem rainbow worksheets.

They can include just one or two words for each line.....

Radiant
Amazing
Interesting
Nice
Beautiful
Outstanding
Wonderful

Or they can include full sentences.....

Red is the colour where the rainbow begins,
Above the other vibrant colours,
In the clear, radiant sky
Never seeming to end,
Beaming with colour after the rain has fallen,
Oh!
What a sight to see!
